For the finale of its 33rd season, the Larimer Chorale, one of northern Colorado's finest choral ensembles, will perform Haydn's masterpiece *The CREATION*, a magnificent musical interpretation of the creation stories as told in the books of Genesis and Psalms and John Milton's *Paradise Lost*. The performance will be enhanced by a visual perspective of art work relating to the themes of *The CREATION* projected on screen during the concert, creating a unique synthesis of the visual and musical arts in a glorious celebration of the natural world around us. A silent auction of art work to benefit the Chorale will be held online during the month of April and live at the Lincoln Center on the day of the concert, May 2, 2010.

Artists are invited to submit images of their work by January 15, 2010.

A panel will select pieces for inclusion in the silent auction and art show.

*A*rt show: images from a select group of 6-8 artists will be chosen for projection on screen during the concert, based on artistic merit and close association with the main themes of *The CREATION*. Each artist whose work is selected for projection will be paid a stipend of \$250.

*A*uction: a wide range of artwork based on the themes of *The CREATION* (see *side bar at left*) will be selected for the silent auction. The Larimer Chorale will retain 50% commission on the sale of artwork; proceeds will benefit the Chorale in its mission to share the gift of great choral music and to inspire new generations with the love of singing. Work that does not sell at or above the minimum bid will be returned to the artist.

*A*rtwork will be posted online during the month of April, 2010. The public will be able to preview the artwork online and to make bids online or via telephone prior to the event (details will be posted online). The live silent auction will take place at the Lincoln Center, May 2, 2010, 5:00-6:30 p.m. and will conclude after the concert at approximately 9:30 p.m.

CONDITIONS AND AGREEMENTS

- Artwork must be offered for sale. Artists may set the minimum bid. The Larimer Chorale will retain a 50% commission on all artwork sold in the silent auction.
- Artists may submit up to 8 images; artists whose work is chosen are guaranteed space for at least 3 pieces in the online and live silent auction.
- Digital images must be high quality, a minimum of 1400 pixels on the longest side, in RGB color mode, and jpg format (please keep file sizes to less than 2 MB). Each digital file should be titled with artist's name and corresponding number on entry form.
- Submission of images via email is preferred but images on CD will also be accepted. CDs will be returned if a self-addressed envelope with sufficient postage is included.
- Artists chosen for projection of artwork during the concert will be paid an additional stipend of \$250.
- Artwork to be sold at auction should be mounted on firm backing and may be framed or unframed (please note whether framed or unframed in the spaces above). Artwork must fit through a standard 34" x 84" door; wall art must not exceed 30 lbs; sculptures/3D art must not exceed 60 lbs.
- Art must be delivered to the Lincoln Center between 3:00-4:30 pm on May 2, 2010, or by prior arrangement ONLY.
- Artists must arrange for removal of unsold art from the Lincoln Center by 10:30 pm on May 2, 2010, in person or by prior arrangement. If by prior arrangement, art must be picked up from designated location by May 16, 2010.
- Artists participating in the auction will receive two free tickets to the concert.

Notification of acceptance of artwork into art show and/or silent auction will include further specifications for work to be submitted for projection (if selected). All artists will be required to sign a waiver of understanding that the submission of artwork for silent auction or projection automatically waives any claims for damage or loss against the Lincoln Center or the Larimer Chorale, their staff members or employees, assigns, or Board of Directors, and grants permission to reproduce in color or black and white images of artwork for exhibition online, or for educational or publicity purposes.
