



FREE MAMMOGRAM & PAP TESTS

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Live in Colorado, or a state bordering Colorado, and receive breast/cervical health care in Colorado

Be 40 to 64 years of age (*women 40-49 will receive a mammogram at the discretion of the provider*)

At or below the 250% Federal Poverty Level

Not have health insurance that covers the screenings or a deductible significant enough to delay or refuse screenings

Not had a mammogram and/or Pap test in the past 12 months. Effective February 25, 2009: Women who have recently lost employer health insurance are welcome into the program. Such women may present with abnormal results of a Pap or mammogram from her former health insurer (please contact the program for further information on enrollment).

Meet Colorado identity and citizenship verification criteria

For families with more than 6 persons, add \$9,350 annually or \$779 monthly for each additional person
